

## HOMEcoming

In late September 2018, Dion, Breanna, and I arrived with boxes and boxes and boxes of books and cherished office decorations at 3011 Leaphart Road. We officially began our ministry with you on October 1, 2018. Our first Sunday, was October 7<sup>th</sup> – Homecoming Sunday! How could it be 5 years ago? As we look back over our years together, we have certainly had our share of challenges opportunities for expanded ministries, especially with the restrictions during COVID. We made it through though! We are better today, having faced our challenges opportunities for sharing the gospel in this kingdom on earth.



In the gospel of Mark, Jesus is documented as being visiting a man who was possessed by an evil spirit. When Jesus casts out the evil spirit. *17Then they [the town's people] began to beg Jesus to leave their neighborhood. 18As he was getting into the boat, the man who had been possessed by demons begged him that he might be with him. 19But Jesus refused, and said to him, "Go home to your friends, and tell them how much the Lord has done for you, and what mercy he has shown you."*

Even in the goodness of Jesus returning the man to the community, others were afraid and maybe lost their source of income from the pigs. Sometimes we do the same thing. We are saddened by the short-term events without being overjoyed by the long-term gains. Many of us rebelled against locked doors, sign-in sheets, masks, distancing in the sanctuary, etc.; however, we gained much too. With an enhanced food pantry, we addressed increased hunger in the community. With limited gatherings, we used technology and social media to become a stronger beacon in this community. We fed the community both physically and spiritually.

Just last week, I met a couple who have not yet been in the sanctuary, yet, they admittedly said they know all about Mt. Hermon. They know because of what COVID forced us to do: use social media to *tell them how much the Lord has done for you, and what mercy he has shown you.*" Even post COVID, we can continue to be a beacon.

As we enter into a sixth year of ministry together on October 1 and then share Homecoming on October 8, we will continue to share what the Lord has done for us! Invite former members and neighbors to come and see and hear these stories of God's faithfulness to God's people.

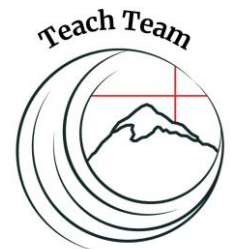

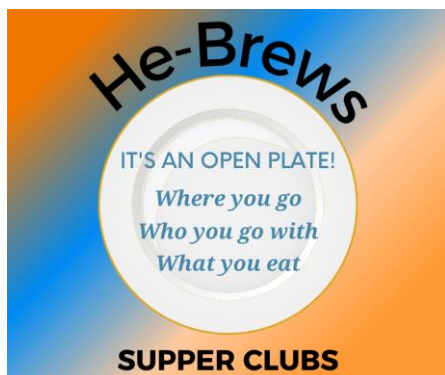
