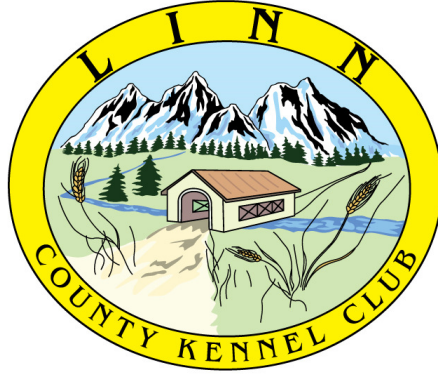

Running Order and Class Information

Please check all your trial information carefully on the confirmation you were sent and notify me immediately in writing with any corrections. You can contact me via email at LKSAGE@aol.com or by phone (503) 840-4303 (cell).

SITE INFO: This trial will be held in two rings indoors on packed dirt. There will be crating on the elevated spectator area around the competition. Crating space is somewhat limited, so we ask that you please conserve on space so that everyone who needs crating will be able to find a spot. Please bring chairs, crates, water and clean up tools for your dogs. **You may set up your crating space Thursday afternoon beginning at 4 pm. IF YOU SET UP BEFORE THIS TIME, WE MAY MOVE YOUR CRATES AND MATS TO MAKE ROOM FOR OUR RAFFLE TABLES AND SECRETARY TABLES.**

Please DO NOT crate along the railings or ring side. There is also covered crating outside along the building. Also a reminder that this agility trial is being held in conjunction with the Linn County Kennel Club breed show. **Note, there is a \$5 parking fee for day parking on Saturday and Sunday.**

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE:

From the North, on I-5: Take EXIT 234A toward Fair/Expo/Knox Butte. Turn slight right onto Airport Road SE. Turn right onto Pacific Blvd. SE/OR-99E. Stay straight to go onto Knox Butte Road E. End at 3700 Knox Butte Road E on the right.

From the South, on I-5: Take EXIT 234 toward Fair/Expo/Knox Butte. Turn right onto Knox Butte Road E. End at 3700 Knox Butte Road E on the right.

MEASURING: All dogs without height cards will have to be measured this weekend. We will have a VMO available at this trial. Handlers whose dogs need to be measured will not be able to get their armbands until they are measured. We will have a VMO available to measure dogs throughout the day on all days. Measuring will take place near the secretary table.

GENERAL: ALL dogs are required to be kept on leash at ALL times. And please pick up after your dogs.

VOLUNTEERS: We will be using the white board system this weekend for volunteering. Please sign up for the class and/or jump height you can work. Volunteers are a very important part of the success of our trials. We'll have a worker raffle each day.

CONFLICTS: We will do our best to accommodate conflicts. If you have a conflict, Put a "C" instead of a check mark on both gate sheets so the scribe and gate stewards will know you have a conflict.

MOVE-UPS: The deadline for move-ups is Monday, February 17, 2020 at 6 pm and must be submitted in writing (email ok). Day-to-Day move-ups will be permitted at these trials and must be submitted to the score table no later than 30 minutes after the end of the trial.

FOOD: There will be a food vendor on site and will be open from 8:30 am to the end of the trial each day. In addition, there are fast food restaurants within a couple of miles of the fairgrounds.

CLASS RUNNING ORDER: The Preliminary Running Order is contingent upon move-up entries not yet received.

FAST CLASS WALK THRU All FAST Classes will walk together. ONE walk thru for all FAST Classes. Then we will Run all FAST Classes together by jump height.

Walk through groups may be changed at the trial to accommodate for workers.
