Message from David and the Events Team

We would like to thank you all for your continued support of Ashtead All Stars Netball Club and the events we arrange. We are all disappointed that we haven't been able to finish the 2019/20 season but the safety of all our players and their families is paramount. In the meantime we have taken the decision to <u>postpone</u> the End of Season Tournament that we had expected to run on 26th April. This has been a fantastic and much loved event in the AAS calendar for the last 9 years and we know that all players and their families look forward to it but we are sure you understand that in the current environment we need to act responsibly.
