The Likumbi Lya Mize is an annual event that features the infamous Makishi masked dancers (spirits of deceased ancestors). The emergence of the Makishi signifies the end of "Mukanda" – an initiation ritual for boys aged 8-12 years who learn life lessons & adulthood at this annual camp.

The Makishi have been declared by UNESCO as "Artefacts of Indelible Culture"

Who can join this tour?
