## **HOCKING TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES**

### **REGULAR SESSION**

Held: March 27, 2018 7:00 PM

### **PUBLIC PARTICIPATION:**

### **REGIONAL PLANNING REPORT:**

They adopted the updated land use plan for Fairfield County.

### **ZONING:**

Zoning Inspector Marshall reported for the month of March. Received phone calls about permits. A total of 3 in the past week and a total of 8 permits to date. McRoberts for a room addition on Stoney Hill Road, Burris for a new build on Mt. Zion Road, and Toth for an accessory building on Jacobs Ladder Road.

### **CORRESPONDENCE FROM THE FISCAL OFFICER:**

Minutes from the February Meeting being read prior by the Board were approved as read, so moved by Trustee Claypool and seconded by Trustee Ellinger. All were in favor with 3 ayes and no negative votes, motion passed. BWC training scheduled for April 17, 2018. Trustee Ellinger

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motioned to move from temporary appropriations to permanent appropriations for FY18. Roll call vote Ellinger – Yes, Claypool – Yes, Wolfe – Yes. Motion approved.

### **FIRE DEPARTMENT:**

Fire Chief Golden reported that Hocking Township had 173 runs to date. There were 13 mutual aids provided.

### **OLD BUSINESS**

1. The new ODOT signs are scheduled to be installed.
2. The property of Jon and Cathy Born is being worked on with Fairfield County Soil and Water. Trustee Claypool motioned to appropriate up to \$5,000 for the townships share of ditch and drainage repair. Trustee Ellinger seconded the motion. Roll call vote Ellinger – Yes, Claypool – Yes, Wolfe – Yes. Motion approved.
3. County Engineer meeting was on March 15, 2018 with all townships.
4. County OTA meeting was held March 10, 2018 at the Liberty Hall.

### **NEW BUSINESS:**

1. April 14, 2018 is the next OTA meeting at 6:00pm and will be held at the fire house in Amanda.
2. The trustees will meet on April 14, 2018 at 8:00am and again on April 21, 2018 at 8:00am to view all roads in Hocking Township.
3. Health Department fees will increase 5 percent this year for all townships.
4. Trustee Ellinger motioned to allocate up to \$3,000 for tree removal in various areas. Trustee Claypool seconded the motion. Roll call vote Ellinger – Yes, Claypool – Yes, Wolfe – Yes. Motion approved.
5. Trustee Claypool motioned to have Ricketts come back and grade the area where work was completed on Barr Drive to be reseeded. This amount will be added to the total force account project that was approved back in October 2017. Trustee Ellinger seconded the motion. Roll call vote Ellinger – Yes, Claypool – Yes, Wolfe – Yes. Motion approved.



There being no further business to discuss Trustee Wolfe motioned to adjourn and Trustee Claypool seconded the motion.






