Reports:

<u>Recording Secretary</u>: Meeting minutes from August meeting were read prior to the meeting by members. Motion to accept the minutes was made by first Bonne Weaver, second by Brad Jess, MC. July meeting minutes were also approved.

Secretary Report:

- ABC computers backup service is increasing by \$10/per month for a total of \$145/month. Looking into other backups service options to compare pricing
- L.A. Bexten offered price cap at \$1.39/gallon for 21/22 winter season on propane. If market price drops below, we will receive the lower price.

Hastings Mutual Insurance company has given a recommendation of improvements for coverage council agrees to putting a fire extinguisher in garage, pad lock on garage doors and will recommend a "hold harmless" contract with new snow removal contractor
