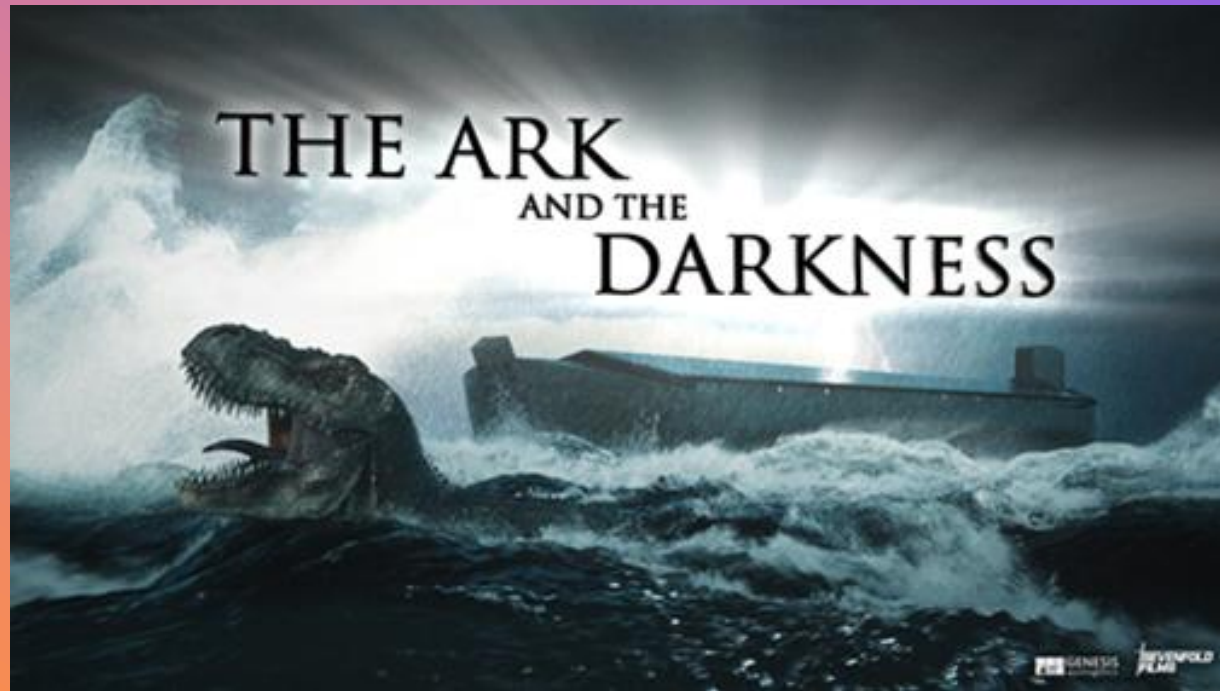

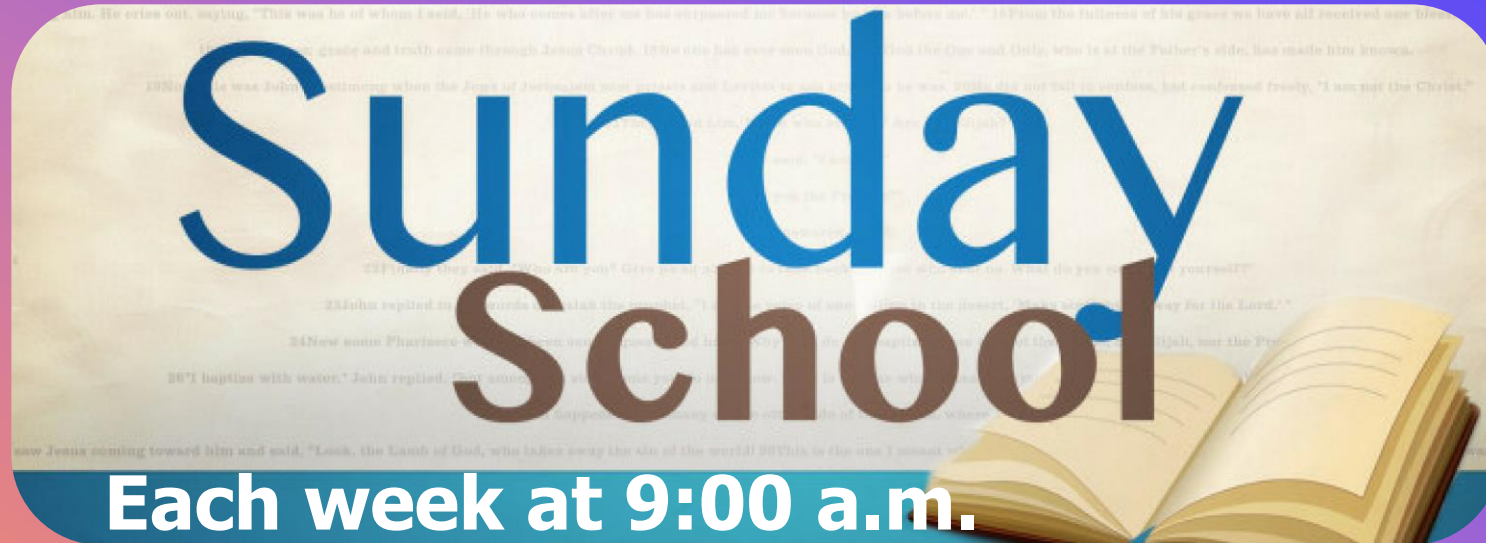
## **Celebration of Life Service for Don & Nancy Robinson**
