Thelma V. Roemer, 74 and a native of Unionville, died Tuesday, Jan. 31, in Holmes Regional Medical Center, Melbourne, FL, following a six-week illness.

She was born in Unionville Sept. 19, 1920, the daughter of Charles and Anna (Hainitz) Hensel. She was married to Elmer Roemer in Kilmanagh Feb. 11, 1940, and he preceded her in death on Aug. 10, 1970. She had lived in the Sebawaing Area before moving to Florida in 1972.
