Preparation and submission of Abstracts

- 1. Abstracts should be prepared as a Word document, using 12 font
- 2. The order of presentation is: Title, Author(s), Objective, Study design, Results, and Conclusion. The name of the presenting author should be underlined
- 3. The body of the abstract (Title, Author(s), Objective, Study design, Results, and Conclusion) is limited to 400 words. One additional graph and/or one additional table may be included on the same page with the abstract, and is/are not included in the word count
- 4. Authors may submit more than one abstract
- 5. All abstracts should be submitted no later than August 15, 2017
- 6. Address all abstracts to SSE Conference Abstract Review Committee at ssep1@verizon.net

On a separate sheet, please:

- 1. Indicate preference for presentation as an oral, poster, or no preference for each abstract
- 2. Give the name, institution, location of institution (including country) postal address (home or institution), e-mail address, and contact telephone number (cell preferable)

After August 15, 2017, all abstracts will be submitted to each member of the organizing committee for review and selection. Authors should be notified by September 1, 2017.
