

Paul made his first concerto debut at the age of 16 at the Whistler Music Festival. He was a recipient of the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation's "Galaxie Rising Stars Award" and placed second in the Canadian National Music Competition in 2008. Paul won the Vancouver Youth Symphony Orchestra's concerto competition in 2009, and in May of 2011 won a spot in the YouTube Symphony and performed with 100 other musicians from around the world at the Sydney Opera House.

As a passionate solo, chamber, and orchestral flute player, Paul has performed in music festivals such as the Banff music festival, Performing Arts BC, Sonic Boom Festival, and with the Vancouver Symphony Orchestra, Vancouver Island Symphony, and Okanagan Symphony. He is also on faculty at the Vancouver Academy of Music and will be serving as the acting principal flute at the Prince George Symphony in 2015-2016 season. While building a musical career, he is pursuing a doctorate degree in music at UBC school of music.
