




World Day For Grandparents and the Elderly July 23rd, 2023

Pope Francis instituted the World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly on January 31, 2021 to highlight the importance of providing adequate pastoral and spiritual attention to the elderly and to call upon communities to manifest the closeness of the Church to them. It is to be celebrated annually on the fourth Sunday of July, close to the memorial of Saints Joachim and Anne, the grandparents of Jesus. The theme chosen by Pope Francis for this year's World Day is "His mercy is from age to age" (Lk 1:50). This theme emphasizes the interconnectedness between the elderly and the young, highlighting the importance of their relationship.
