### **Preschool**

- Back pack or book bag small enough to fit inside locker
- Shoes that completely cover the foot. No sandals please.

#### **Grades DK & K**

- Book bag that fits in locker
- 1 canister of Play-Dough (labeled with name)
- Well-fitting shoes that your child can tie or fasten themselves (tying several sets of shoes several times a day is time consuming). Please keep in mind the active nature of young children. Safety is most important.
- 1 box of 10 Classic Color Markers
- 1 Pink block eraser
- Closable Water bottle (non-disposable)

#### **Grades 1 & 2**

- Book bag that fits in locker
- Headphones or ear buds for computer use
- Well-fitting shoes that your child can tie or fasten themselves (tying several sets of shoes several times a day is time consuming). Please keep in mind the active nature of young children. Safety is most important.
- 1 Sturdy Plastic Pocket Folder
- 1 Pink block eraser
- 2 Elmer's Glue sticks
- 1 Composition book, wide-rule
- Closable Water bottle (non-disposable)

#### **Grades 3, 4, 5**

- 1 Spiral notebook
- Pencils
- Pink block eraser
- 2 Elmer's Glue sticks
- Ruler
- Book bag that **fits** in locker
- Only 2 Ballpoint pens
- 1 Pocket folder
- Scissors
- Colored pencils
- Markers
- 16" x 9" pencil box is sufficient if the student desires one or zippered pocket
- Closable Water bottle (non-disposable)
- SUPER SIZE SETS OF CRAYONS, COLORED PENCILS, OR MARKERS ARE NOT NECESSARY.
- Headphones for computer use

Optional items:

Sticky notes 2x3 - 1 highlighter - Scotch Tape - Pencil/crayon sharpener

# Supply List for Grades 6-8

## Required Supplies:

- ✓ Bible (one will be provided for new students)
- ✓ No. 2 pencils or mechanical pencils
- ✓ 1 or 2 colored pens
- ✓ 1 package of college-ruled loose-leaf paper
- ✓ 5 one-subject spiral-bound notebooks (no multi-subject notebooks)
- ✓ At least 5 pocket folders
- ✓ 1 three-ring binder (one inch)
- ✓ Scissors
- ✓ Three-ring pencil pouch to hang from your desk (rings provided at school)
- ✓ 1 box of Kleenex
- ✓ Headphones or ear buds for computer use
- ✓ Calculator
- o 6th graders: any basic calculator is fine
- o 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders: at least a scientific calculator (\$10-\$20) is required. Graphing calculators (\$90+) may also be used. Students will be required to have a graphing calculator in high school. If you are considering purchasing a new graphing calculator for your child to use now and in the future, I recommend the TI-84 Plus. Please do <u>not</u> buy anything by Casio. If you have questions about calculators, please ask Mr. Faupel before you go out and buy one.

# Do <u>NOT</u> bring:

- \* Art supplies (crayons, markers, etc.); these will be provided at school
- \* Desktop organizers (they take up too much space and are not necessary)
- Staplers or tape dispensers (these are available in the classroom)
- \* Anything that will be a distraction or is not necessary for school
