PRAYERS FOR ALL SOULS AND OUR BELOVED DEPARTED

On All Souls Day, we not only remember the dead, but we apply our efforts through prayer, almsgiving, and the Mass, to their release from Purgatory.

CHRISTIAN OBLIGATION: Praying for the dead is a Christian obligation. In the modern world, when many have come to doubt the Church's teaching on Purgatory, the need for such prayers has only increased. The Church devotes the month of November to prayer for the souls in Purgatory, and participation in the Mass of All Souls Day is a good way to begin the month.

WHAT IS PURGATORY? (Catholic Catechism Nos. 1030-1032): "All who die in God's grace and friendship, but still imperfectly purified, are indeed assured of their eternal salvation; but after death they undergo purification, so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of heaven. The Church gives the name Purgatory to this final purification of the elect, which is entirely different from the punishment of the damned..."

GREAT ACT OF CHARITY TO PRAY FOR DEAD: Prayer for the dead, is one of the greatest acts of charity we can perform. Through our prayers, we can help the faithful departed during their time in Purgatory, so that they can enter more quickly into the fullness of Heaven.

Eternal Rest Prayer: "Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May the souls of the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. Amen." Pray for the Holy Souls every day and they will certainly pray for you and welcome you to heaven.




