





Human Trafficking in our Midst: A Catholic Response - Learn what human trafficking is, when and where it occurs, and what we as Catholics can do to address it. An informational session on human trafficking will be presented on Monday, May 13 at 6:30 p.m. in the Cathedral Hall at St. Patrick Cathedral, Harrisburg by John Leedock and Christina Szoke-Lou of Catholic Charities' Immigration and Refugee Services. Human trafficking isn't limited to large cities; it occurs right here in south central Pennsylvania. Eliminating human trafficking and empowering survivors has been a historic concern of the Catholic Church.
