

June 2003 (updated in 2011)

Map Update: This map version was updated in 2011 to add an aerial photo base and improve readability. The open space vision and ownership shown are unchanged from the Rivers to Ridges Vision that was endorsed in 2003.

The Rivers to Ridges vision has been endorsed by the Lane County Board of Commissioners (2/03), the Eugene City Council (3/03), the Willamalane Park and Recreation District Board (4/03), and the Springfield City Council (5/03).



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

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
