RULES AND REGULATIONS

- All riders and exhibitors must wear USEF approved (ASTM/SEI) headgear at all times while mounted. Jeans are not allowed.
- Management reserves the right to change, alter, combine, cancel, or add classes, dates, and personnel.
- Red Oak Farm, LLC, and its owners, managers, employees, staff, volunteers will NOT be held responsible for any accident, illness, injury (including death), loss, or damage occurring at the show.
- All entry forms are to be completely filled out, signed, and presented (fax, mail, email, or in person) to the secretary along with full payment before numbers will be assigned. No one will be allowed to show without a number.
- Parking will be allowed in designated areas only; exhibitors, trainers, and spectators agree to follow the parking official's instructions.
- Tying horses to fences and/or use of paddocks is not permitted.
- All pets must be leashed while on the show grounds-NO exceptions.
- All entries and horses on grounds must pay \$20 Office/EMT fee.
- \$50 fee for all returned checks. Entries will forfeit future showing privilege at Red Oak Farm until all fees have been paid.
- All prize money won will be mailed out 3 weeks following the horse show.
- All horses at show must have a negative EIA test within one year and had all appropriate vaccinations.
- All horse and rider combinations entering in M&S point classes must be entered in at least one other class at the same show.
- Each trainer/exhibitor is responsible for knowing and following all USEF, NJPHA, NJHSA, M&S League, and Red Oak Farm horse show rules.
- As an agreement as entry into the show the following is effective for all: **WARNING: UNDER NEW JERSEY LAW, AN EQUESTRIAN AREA OPERATOR IS NOT LIABLE FOR AN INJURY TO OR THE DEATH OF A PARTICIPANT IN EQUINE ANIMAL ACTIVITIES RESULTING FROM THE INHERENT RISKS OF EQUINE ANIMAL ACTIVITIES, PURSUANT TO P.L., 1997, c. 287 (C.5:15-1 et seq).**

Open to all. To be judged on performance and soundness with emphasis on manners. Fence height 2'6.

200. Marshall & Sterling Children's/ Adults 2'6 Medal

Open to Junior/ Amateur Riders on horses or ponies that are not competing at the same show in any class in which the fences exceed 3'. Three riders must complete the course in order for points to count. The rider must be a member in order for points to count toward qualifying for the Finals. No cross entry of rider into the M&S Children's Pony Medal at the same show.

Pre-Children's/Adult Equitation NJHSA

Open to riders who are still limit riders as of Dec. 1st. Fences are not to exceed 2'0" for ponies and 2'6" for the horses. If entries warrant, the division will be split for a separate Children's and Adult division.

Ten or 1/3 of the top of the class will return to do a second round over approximately 12 jumps. There will be 3 heights: one set at 3', one set at 2'6", one set at 2'. They will be judged together. Pinned through 10th place and first rounds are to be run concurrent with jump height sections.
