July 9, 2015

Meeting duly advertised and called to order at 7:00pm with reading of the Open Public Records statement and Pledge of Allegiance.

Commissioners' Symons, Poppe Jr., Rubio, Wickham and Ryan in attendance as well as Attorney Rich Braslow and Accountant Oliver Walling.

<u>Attorney's Report/ Accountant's Report</u>
Attorney Braslow reported on a proposed amendment to the election bill – (capital portion). O. Walling advised that it was OK to amend budget for unanticipated income/unanticipated expense.

Motion to accept the following resolutions by Commissioner V. Rubio, 2nd by K. Wickham, approved:

(23-15) Resolution to adopt Amendment to 2015 Budget;

(24-15) Resolution authorizing employment of part time inspectors.

O. Walling reviewed the procedure to follow for the monies received from the sale of the cell tower lease.

R. Braslow advised that the Township hearing reference the Districts consolidation will probably be in August.

O. Walling would like to start the budget process right after Labor Day. The expected 95,000.00 savings (due to consolidation) for 2015 would stay in the budget for 2016. District voters should be reminded at the budget hearing that the consolidation goal is for both long term savings (in addition to initial savings) and greater immediate efficiency.

If a Safer Grant is applied for, it will not be a part of the budget.

Motion by Commissioner Rubio, 2nd by Commissioner Poppe to go to closed session at 1930.

Motion to reopen meeting by Commissioner Rubio , 2nd by Commissioner Poppe. Meeting reopened at 1935 hours.

Chief's Report/CVFC

Lt. G. Schoen only CVFC Officer present at meeting. The continued absence from meetings, the lack of required monthly reports, and violations of vehicle use policies (out of town use) by both the Chief and Assistant Chief was discussed. Motion to revoke the use of the vehicles from both for 2 weeks by Commissioner Wickham, 2nd by Commissioner Poppe; approved. The Board also reserves the right to take further action depending upon explanations offered. The Captain and 1st lieutenant will use the vehicles. Chief J Alchevsky and A/C J. Langguth will be contacted.

Lt. Schoen presented a Purchase Request for 3 sets of gear – Approved.

<u>Career Lt/FF Report</u> Apparatus maintenance and repair; progress. All purchase requests submitted approved.

The Board requests an inventory list of pagers (current, broken, etc...)

Career FF J Poppe III submitted to Commissioner Symons a breakdown of required costs, training, and equipment references water rescue team. Lt. Schoen to find out how many members would be interested.

Commissioner Rubio to check on 5639 title.

The Board questioned why '3 year EMTexperience for per diem firefighter. Lt. Mergner advised that this requirement was previously approved, prior to advertising for position. It was decided to keep the application process open until August 31, 2015

Lt. Mergner requested that the gray (2008) pickup be returned to the Fire Prevention Bureau for both fire inspections and fire investigation equipment. All Board members agreed to return the truck but requested that it wait until the status of the white pickup (2006) is determined as a vehicle needs to be available for the air trailer. The Board needs a determination as to the safety of the 2006 pickup. It's OK to start switching/loading equipment into the 2008 truck but it has to remain at St. 56-1 to tow the trailer. FF Poppe III advised that the brush truck is also available to tow the trailer. The Bureau is to establish a policy to return the truck in the event of a fire requiring the air trailer

Fire Prevention Bureau S. Rauch reported progress.

Motion by Commissioner Rubio, 2nd by Commissioner Ryan to go to closed session at 2025.

Motion to reopen meeting by Commissioner Rubio , 2nd by Commissioner Wickham. Meeting reopened at 2040 hours.

Assistant Chief Langguth was called into meeting and the problems were explained to him.

A letter will be sent to the Chief and Assistant Chief reference deficiencies – Percentages for the past 3 months; Safety Officer's report is overdue; Violation of vehicle policy (out of town use); No attendance at Board meetings; No monthly reports; No attendance at Township Chief's meetings. Chief Alchevsky was advised of all this and should have relayed all information to the Assistant Chief. Further, a letter to the Board will be requested from the Chief and Assistant Chief outlining the reasons why.

The SOG's are to be completed by Districts 1 & 2 prior to January 1, 2016.

Assistant Chief Langguth's vehicle will be returned immediately. Chief ALchevsky's vehicle will be obtained once the spare key is located (Chief is currently out of state).

Motion by Commissioner Poppe, 2nd by Commissioner Ryan to adjourn at 2055 hours; approved.
