# I. Basic Overview

#### A. Coordinator

1. Coordinator for 2018-2019: Chelsea Witte

#### B. Location

1. PJP2A After School Program is held on school grounds, usually the library. Students will normally go to play or do activities outside after they complete their homework time.

### C. Hours

1. Monday - Friday 3:00 - 5:45 p.m.

# II. Enrollment & Cost

## A. General Enrollment & Participation

- An enrollment packet will be provided to parents who wish to enroll their child in our program which provides pertinent information to the after-school coordinator. A parent or designated guardian must sign the child out of the program when coming to pick them up.
- 2. Maximum enrollment is 20 students.

# B. Priority Enrollment

1. Priority enrollment is given to kindergarten students as Boys & Girls Club does not offer services for these students.

## C. Enrollment of Other Students

- 1. Participation in the After School Crusader Program is limited to currently enrolled students of the Academy (grades K-8).
- 2. Students must be in good academic and behavioral standing in order to participate.

## D. Cost & Payment Information

#### 1. General Fees

Charge	Service
\$100	1 child for the month*
\$50	Sibling per month*
\$50	5-day regular punch pass
\$35	Sibling regular punch pass
\$25	Homework hour punch pass (5 uses per month)

<sup>\*</sup> A month denotes a calendar month. Hence, a family should pay \$100 for the month of September, but this money would not transfer for any services into October.

**Families with more than one participant:** The first child of each family is charged the full rate; each additional sibling is charged the discounted rate.

#### 2. Payment

- a) Order forms will be sent home regularly in the Wednesday folders and can always be picked up in the school office.
- b) Payments should be made out to Pope John Paul II Academy

# III. Rules & Procedures

#### A. Basic Rules

 Adherence to General Academy Rules: All regular school protocol will be followed during the after-school program. The coordinator is responsible for becoming familiar with the school's protocol.

#### 2. "Strike" System

- **a.** Students with behavior issues will be expected to comply with a "strike" system.
- **b.** If a student receives two strikes in a week, or three strikes within a month, they will be automatically suspended from the program for the following month.
- c. If a student again receives three strikes in the returning month, they will be expelled from the program for the duration of the school year.

#### 3. Safety & Security

a. Safety is the number one priority: students must follow the direction of the coordinator and/ or helpers.

- b. Students are to be supervised at all times.
- c. Parents must sign out students when they pick them up.

# B. Procedures & Pick-Up

- 1. Students who participate in the After School Program are to meet in the designated area at dismissal time.
- 2. Parents are to sign out their students when they arrive to pick them up.
- 3. Students must be picked up by 5:45 pm. <u>Parents will be charged \$1 per minute after 5:45 pm upon the second occurrence of a late pick-up.</u>

### C. Schedule

3:00 – 3:30 p.m.	Snack and Recess
3:30 – 4:30 p.m.	Homework & Reading
4:30 – 5:30 p.m.	Recess or Group Activity

- 1. A small snack will be provided for the students, but students may bring their own food.
- 2. A "Homework Hour" pass is meant for students to remain in the club for up to 1 hour and 15 minutes, and is especially meant to aid those students participating in after-school events such as volleyball, basketball, band, or other programs.
