Interpretation Memo: Medical Travel.

In negotiations a better understanding of the terminology used in our medical travel policy was obtained as follows:

- On page 7 of the Bargaining Unit Employee Benefits Summary (yellow booklet), Medical Travel Coverage, the term “local” is used to mean two different things.
 - When speaking of services not being available locally, this is to mean “not available in Quesnel”. You then are referred to a service outside. The outside service can be supplied “locally” – meaning Prince George or Williams Lake, or “out of town” – meaning everywhere else.
- The Note on the back of the Medical Travel Form also deals with this definition of “local” and needs to be kept in mind.
