




Amazon Affiliate

US House of Representatives:

<u>HR 8</u>

<u>HR 1446</u>

The House passed both bills on March 11th.

HR 8 - expands background checks for all firearm sales or transfers in the country.

HR 1446 – increases the time an FFL receives a 'delay' on a transfer to up to 30 days before the FFL can transfer the firearm.

These bills are now in the Senate waiting to be introduced to the appropriate committee and then onto the floor for a vote.

Contact your representatives and let them know how you feel about this to bills.
