- 1. Rotary Press Upgrade
 - Scheduled to have a mobile press demonstration at the WWTP Spring 2023 by Tim Tomasko.(no date has been chosen as of this meeting date)
 - Project requires a Part II Permit, which can take 6-10 months.
 - ▶ Lead time for the press is an additional 8-10 months.
 - Project was previously submitted for a grant.
 - Grant agency required additional information such as cost analysis, audits, and articles of incorporation.
 - Project to be submitted to the grant board in September for a decision on fundingproject on hold until then.
- 3. Chapter 94 Reporting
