Our vinyl siding is scheduled for a pressure wash to clean and revitalize our buildings during the week of September 16. During the washing process all windows and patio doors should be closed to allow the cleaning to proceed without interruption! The board assumes no responsibility for any damage to the interior of a unit due to windows or doors being left open. We would like to thank everyone for their cooperation during the resealing of the streets. All cars were moved prior to the sealing, therefore no towing was necessary. We also want to thank the church for their generous offer of the use of their parking lot.

During the spring and summer of 2013 the PG HOA has been very aggressively perusing several maintenance and upgrade projects. While attempting to maintain our landscaping to your standards, make necessary repairs to our building exteriors and 'tame' some of the foundation shrubs which seem to be overgrown somewhat, we have managed to make several improvements along the way.

This year has seen the addition of curbs on the corners of PG Circle and PG Dr. We were able to get these new curbs backfilled to enable the addition of new shrubs to enhance the overall look of our property. This project should be complete by the spring of 2014, after the backfill has settled and the areas to be mulched are completed.

We have been able to rearrange the rocks lining the hill adjacent to the Gene Snyder Freeway to allow for a better turn radius for larger vehicles. Additionally, we have constructed a rock framing for the culvert which is located in the SW corner of our property and will be able to construct a basin to make this storm drain blend more naturally into our landscaping. The PG storage shed has been skirted to provide for a cleaner look.

We have been able to add eight trees to our landscaping, some replacement trees for those that have died, and some to provide new trees to replace those which are aging and may need to be replaced as time goes on.

We have been able to 'clean up' the area between our property and the Paddock (adjacent to Factory Lane) to provide a more appealing curb appeal to our community.

Charcoal and gas grills (and other similar devices) and fire pits are restricted from all common areas. (Please see Kentucky Fire Code). Grills are not allowed on decks and should be at least 10 feet away from the structure. No open fires are permitted.
