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Mr. Fred Leffingwell, Manager of The Bus Barn presented information regarding securing a waiver or variance to allow the surface area to be the buffer on the north side of the expansion. The Administrator stated that this expansion does not meet current drainage requirements and Mr. Vial concurred that drainage requirements are in place and that he cannot support the variance. The Board agreed that all current drainage requirements would have to be met.

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Mr. Chuck Spangler of Spangler Engineering presented the Board with bid results from the IDA Tree/Debris Removal – NRCS Phase 1-A Project. He recommended that the Drainage District award the bid to the lowest bidder that met all bid requirements. A motion was made by Mr. Vial and seconded by Mr. Wells to accept the recommendation of Mr. Chuck Spangler of Spangler Engineering and award the Public Bid for the IDA Tree/Debris Removal – NRCS Phase 1-A Project to the lowest bidder, Chem Spray South, Inc., in the amount of \$5,180,596.00.
