- Owners submitting their resumes should be current on their maintenance fees and should plan on attending the Annual Election Meeting on November 12, 2022.



Pending Future projects

WINDOW REPLACEMENT PROJECT-3rd phase

We have tentative plans to continue the third phase of our window projects which will take place sometime in 2023—2024 timeframe. This phase will be replacing the store-front windows and will be done one quarter of the building at a time starting on the beachside.

HOT TUB

We had plans to install a new hot tub due to the high maintenance of the existing 40 year old hot tub. In checking it seems that in order for us to do this, we would need 75 percent of the owners to consent to do so. We are continuing to research this legality.

FLOORING

Currently the second and third floors flooring with the laminated tile are completed. The seventh floor is scheduled to be completed this fall (October—December time period).

DRAPERY

The Association has purchased enough material to begin installing new hardware and drapes this fall as rooms become available.











2022 In-House Exchange Program

The resort offers the opportunity to owners to exchange their unit owned weeks for another week within the resort based on availability. The in-house exchange fee is \$49, and the policy requirements are as follows:

- Owners will have to choose their week as soon as they call to put their unit up for deposit.
- Owners may only exchange their week 30 days prior to their unit/ week arrival date.
- Owners must be current on their maintenance fees.
- Owners may only choose units that are the same size as what they own and within the current year of deposit.

All units are based on availability.

Parking

Parking is limited! The resort offers **one** parking spot for each unit in the garage. However, the garage clearance is 6' 9", so in the event that your vehicle doesn't fit in the basement, you will need to park upfront. It will be subject to a first come, first serve basis as there is only twelve spots and we cannot reserve or hold parking spots. All vehicles must be registered to avoid towing at owner's expense.

No trailers, boats, mobile homes or RV's and the like are allowed on the property.

No Smoking of any kind in the units

There will be a \$250 fee charged to any owner or guest that violates this rule. No smoking is allowed on the property, except in the designated smoking area on the south side of the building.

Your unit/week confirmation of arrival

Marine Terrace offers many options for you to choose from if you are unable to use your unit/week. We would like to ask that you do the following:

- Check the attached calendar so that you know when you are scheduled for arrival of your unit and week.
- Call the resort to confirm your arrival or if you are unable to come, let us give you a few options that you can choose from .

Sorry no pets allowed

Pets are not permitted on our property except for Service Animals as governed by the American with Disabilities Act (ADA). Service animals must be under the control of their owner at all times meaning they should be on a leash and cannot be left in the unit alone and unattended. If you have a Service Animal, you must call the front desk to register your Animal prior to arrival at least one week in advance. Certified Emotional & Therapy Animals <u>are not permitted</u> and do not fall under the regulations of the Americans with Disabilities Act. (ADA) Any owner or guest that violates the rules of the ADA will be reported and charged \$250.

RESPECT YOUR PROPERTY AND OTHER OWNERS

Recently owners/owner guests have been disrespecting the Marine Terrace property and other owners during their stay here. Children are running around with no parental guidance and damage to the property and units has increased our costs. This is your home away from home. Please respect it.

Owners that own weeks during this time please be cautious and ensure your lights are out or your drapes are closed to avoid being fined by Volusia County.



MESSAGE FROM YOUR BOARD PRESIDENT

DEAR FELLOW OWNERS,

The good news is the Association's financial position is solid. Our reserves are funded 100 percent. Because of the building collapse in south Florida, insurance premiums everywhere have gone through the roof. In May, we spent many hours negotiating our insurance renewal with our carrier which ended up increasing almost 40% over the last policy year. Hopefully at our September budget meeting, we will be able to maintain our maintenance fees with a possible small or no increase. Units are selling. Year-to-date we have sold thirty units bringing \$14,625 in revenue to the association.

Our building was recently inspected by our insurance carrier which resulted in a few minor issues which are being corrected. Inspections for the fire alarm, fire extinguishers and fire sprinklers are done on a quarterly and/or annual basis.

Post pandemic, our biggest struggle is to be able to get product and manpower. Our housekeeping employees have been working tirelessly to sanitize and keep our resort safe. Our maintenance personnel are continuing to renovate our units as they become available. It has been difficult to get qualified personnel on our front desk.

Your input with new ideas and suggestions are vital. At this time of year we are on hurricane watch and are keeping our fingers crossed for a safe season.
