## Maintenance Items

This week, new boot covers were installed over vent pipes on all roofs. The original rubber boots were showing signs of drying out and cracking. All gutters have been cleaned. Door frame repairs were completed on 5 Sussex models. The final leaf clean up will take place before the end of the month by Bruzzi. Other recommendations to be mindful of: Interior shutoff for outside hose bibs should be turned off and faucets opened to drain excess water. Occupants should always keep heat at a minimum of 55' even when away. Also it is recommended that water pipes be drained if residents are away for an extended period of time in winter. Dryer lint screens should be cleaned after every use and dryer vent lines cleaned out every 2-3 years depending on usage. Most hot water heaters have reached their life expectancy of around 10 years. Many residents have already had these replaced. Smoke alarms and carbon dioxide detectors should be inspected, and batteries replace twice a year. Also those with wood burning fireplaces should have their chimneys inspected and cleaned periodically depending on usage.
