TECO TO TAKE GUESTS closer TO TAMPA CONVENTION CENTER

Getting from the Tampa Convention Center to Hyatt Regency Tampa and the rest of downtown will be quicker and easier by the end of 2010. A 1/3-mile extension of the TECO Line Streetcar System to the corner of Franklin and Whiting Streets has been under way since October, and is scheduled to open by the end of the year. Right now, the streetcar line ends on Franklin Street, just south of Channelside Drive near the Tampa Convention Center. The extension will take the line north on Franklin, under the Selmon Expressway overpass, through the Brorein intersection, and just past the Ft. Brooke garage. The new end of the line will be between the downtown YMCA and Hattricks, and across the street from the Poe Plaza esplanade.
