Who Are We?

The Friends of Potawatomi State Park was founded in 1995 to host the RunWild event. Having just celebrated its 20 year anniversary, the friends group has grown to include all aspects of preserving, protecting, promoting and providing to make Potowatomi State Park a crown jewel of Wisconsin State Parks.

What Do We Do?

Funding: The annual *RunWild* Event is the major fund raising event for the Park.
The October event consists of a 5K Run/Walk, Quarter-Marathon, and Kid's Run.
Park Maintenance & Care: We take on the responsibility to be the keepers of the Park — building, planting, cleaning and grooming to ensure visitors have the best experience possible. This is our house and we want to present the best to our guests.
Public Education: We fund the Park naturalist position and the Nature Center where you and your family can learn about the wonders of the natural world and the unique features of Potawatomi State Park.

Trail Maintenance: We fund the snow trail grooming equipment and supply volunteers for trail maintenance. This includes year round hiking/biking trail upkeep and signage.

Invasive Species: We monitor and control invasive species such as garlic mustard, honeysuckle, and phragmites.

Playground Areas: We maintain the playground areas and fund new equipment such as the new dirt diggers and the spinning Comet.

Park Store: We operate a store with food, hot & cold drinks, ice cream treats, various supplies, gifts & clothing, firewood, as well as bike, kayak and paddleboard rentals. **New Projects:** We provide input to fund, install, and monitor new projects such as the planned handicap accessible pier by the shelter.
