

POULTRY EXHIBIT RULES

1. Recopy Form. No other form will be accepted.
 2. One exhibitor per form.
 3. A limit of 15 poultry entries per exhibitor/30 per family.
 4. One entry per line.
 5. MAIL FORM to ALISA SCHUMER, 2589 PCR 501, Perryville, MO 63775 by postmark date of Wednesday, August 20, 2014.
 6. One entry per class per exhibitor.
 7. We are not responsible for any defect, lost, or stolen exhibit while entered at East Perry Fair.
 8. No container will be provided to you for feed or water. No water or feed will be put in your cage.
 9. All exhibits must be in place by Thursday, September 18 at 8:00 PM and must remain in place until Saturday, September 20 at 4:00 PM.
 10. The shed will open Thursday, September 18 at 5:00 PM until 8:00 PM for exhibits.
 11. The shed will be close at 8:00 AM Friday, September 19, for judging purposes.
 12. All poultry exhibits must comply with the Health and Sanitation requirements as in the General Rules & Regulations below on this sheet. Bring test results with you if dated within 90 days prior to fair dates.
 13. All exhibits that must be pullorum and typhoid tested must be at the shed by 8:00 PM Thursday night. (State Poultry Veterinarian enforced).
 14. All exhibits must be removed from the shed from 4:00 PM - 8:00 PM Saturday.
 15. Once an exhibit is in the cage tagged for that exhibit, it may not leave such cage under any circumstances.
 16. No exhibits may be brought up from the 4-H/FFA shed to open at any time.
- (A) An official representing the person or organization sponsoring the exhibition shall notify the state veterinarian no later than thirty (30) days prior to the exhibition giving the names, place, inclusive dates and times of the event.
- (B) The sponsor of the exhibition shall compile a list of all poultry present at the exhibition. The list shall contain the name and addresses of each owner, the number, species, breed, variety, type, sex and pullorum-typhoid status of all poultry present. A copy of the list shall be retained by the sponsor of the exhibition for at least twelve (12) months.

Intrastate and Interstate Exhibitors

All birds, except water fowl, shall be tested and negative for pullorum-typhoid within ninety (90) days prior to the exhibition except:

Poultry from a US Pullorum-Typhoid clean or equivalent flocks. This information will be recorded on a NPIP form 15 or form 3B or similar certification which will accompany the poultry during the exhibition.
