Discretionary Use

48/21 M. Lang: That Council approves the Discretionary Use Permit (DUP) for a temporary Campground located on SW-07-19-05-2 Blk/Par F-Plan 101938888 Ext 3 Surface Parcel Number 203186572 upon payment of the DUP fees and subject to the following:

Project Understanding

Based on the information provided, that the applicant is proposing to develop a campground with a total of eleven (11) campsites. The development is for temporary use; the long-term use of the parcel has not yet been determined. Amenities such as a confectionary, laundromat, shower facilities, etc. have not been proposed. Although amenities are not a requirement, washroom facilities should be provided onsite. There is an existing roadway, internal to the source parcel, which would provide access to the campsites.

Zoning Compliance

Based on the RM's zoning map, Parcel F is zoned Agricultural District. Pursuant to Clause 5.2(16) of the Bylaw, campgrounds are a discretionary use in the Agricultural District. The proposed use therefore complies with zoning. The applicant will need to comply with the development standards for campgrounds, which are listed in subsection 3.28 of the Bylaw as well as subsection 5.4.2 Area Building Frontage and Setback Regulations. Prior to permit issuance, to ensure all zoning requirements are met and that the campsite is within property boundaries, a legal survey must be conducted and submitted to the RM.

Sensitive Environment (SE) Overlay

10.2: The boundary of the Sensitive Environment Overlay corresponds to the Valley Planning Area. The development is site within the Valley Planning Area.

10.6(2): With the exception of single-detached dwellings, all development within this Overlay District shall require an environmental assessment. The assessment should identify any potential impacts of the proposed development on the environment, including critical habitat, rare and endangered species, wetlands, etc. The report should also identify mitigation measures recommended to prevent adverse impacts to the natural environment.

Flood Hazard (FH) Lands Overlay

There doesn't appear to be a map defining the boundary of the overlay area. However, it is suggested that the campsites should be located above the 1:500 flood elevation for the site. At minimum, the campsites should be located on higher ground, meeting both the RM Zoning Bylaw setbacks as well as any setbacks set out by Water Security Agency.

Heritage Resource (HR) Overlay

13.2: the Heritage Resource Overlay applies to land in major river valleys and land within 1.0 km of the edge of the valley, as well as land in proximity to a recorded heritage resource site. The Bylaw provides specific information regarding the boundaries of the overlay area.

Proposed development within this overlay area may require a Heritage Resource Impact Assessment (HRIA).

The Heritage Conservation Branch, Ministry of Parks, Culture, and Sport must be contacted to obtain information regarding the location of heritage sensitive land. A copy of the Exempt Activities Checklist and directed to the Developers' Online Screening Tool (DOST) for heritage sensitivity will be provided to the applicant. An approval to proceed from the mentioned party's must be submitted the RM prior to permit issuance.

Temporary Permit Validity
March 01, 2021 to March 01, 2022.

Subdivision

As the campground is temporary, as stated on the application, after March 01, 2022 should the applicant's intent change, the subdivision process shall be required.
