2017 Waimea Christmas Light Parade

Important Information for Entrants to Keep:

1. Staging Area: Waimea Canyon Middle School parking lot. All entrants must be at staging area by 4:00 pm for lineup. Check in station will be open at 3:00 pm to receive your lineup number and parade rules.
2. Parade begins promptly at 6:15 pm. Staging Directors are WKBPA Steve Lupkes and Blaise Boyle. They will be wearing the bright yellow shirts.
3. In route stops for riflery, musical, or dance performances. Limit performance to 30 seconds or less so parade is not delayed. 1) Library 2) Fire Station 3) Ishihara Market
4. Spacing: Units should stay approximately **25 feet** behind the float or unit ahead. If unit ahead is performing, stop and allow performance to finish (30 seconds or less). Maintain your distance.
5. Walking units: Ensure that all walkers are properly lighted and walk within the boundaries of the unit. Small children should be in strollers or wagons. Children old enough to walk or ride manual or motorized toys/bikes shall be supervised by an adult at all times. Your signage should be big enough so that it can be read easily from both sides of the street.
6. Marching units: Ensure that all marchers are properly lighted and march within the boundaries of the unit. Limit performance to 30 seconds or less.
7. Candy: Throwing candy into the crowd is not allowed for safety reasons. However, candy may be handed out to the crowd along the parade route. It is recommended that adults and children 12 and older hand out candy.
8. At the end of parade, all floats are required to return to Waimea Canyon Park for dismantling and disbursement. **FLOATS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO PARK AT HOFGAARD PARK.**
9. REMINDER TO ALL ENTRANTS! This is a drug, alcohol, and smoke-free event. Absolutely no drugs, alcohol, or smoking on school premises and during parade. Any person disobeying the law shall be turned over to the authorities and dealt with accordingly.
10. Please kokua and take your opala with you. Do not leave any trash (such as candy wrappers, cans/bottles) on the school grounds or along the route.
