

DO YOU WANT **FAIR ELECTIONS**? Do you want **CLEAN VOTER ROLLS**? We need your help. Our Newaygo County clerks do their best to keep our voter rolls clean, but there are many ways that keep them from knowing who to remove:

- 1) Someone moved out of the jurisdiction but did not tell the clerk.
- 2) Your adult children moved away without the clerk being aware.
- 3) A parent/family member died, especially when out of county, and the clerk is not aware.
- 4) You purchased a home, but the previous owners are still listed as registered there, because they never alerted the clerk to remove their names.
- 5) You never wanted to be registered, but the Secretary of State automatically did so when you applied/reapplied for your driver's license or a state ID – you might not even know you're registered.

#### **HERE'S HOW YOU CAN HELP:**

Go to **CHECKMYVOTE.ORG** and click on **Tools**, then **Audit My Address**. There you will be able to fill in the requested information to find all the people at your address who are currently registered to vote. This even works for nursing homes, etc.

PLEASE NOTE that when you enter your street number, do **NOT** also enter your street NAME in the same entry. That will be entered separately a couple entries down. Also do not add St or Ave or Dr, etc. to the street NAME entry – again, that's another couple entries down.

Once done, click on the BLUE button on the bottom that says **LOOK UP ADDRESS**. All registered voters will be listed on the next screen.

Then call or visit your clerk. Let her/him know those who no longer reside at your address but are still listed as registered to vote. We're sure there are LOTS of former residents of Newaygo County who have moved away or passed away, but they are still on the voter rolls. **Let's do our best to help make our county one of the cleanest!**
