### FROM THE PRES

Robbie and I visited the Mt Diablo Club in the middle of the month because they had a speaker from the Air Force talking about the Pay-pase (now called Upgraded Early alert) system. This is the cause for all the turn-downyou- power letters being sent owners of 440 repeaters.

It seems that the Air Force is in charge of the radar station at Beale Air Force near Sacramento. We were told that their main mission is to monitor launches of rockets headed our way. They also keep track of space junk so that things don't hit each other in space. Several years ago, the Chinese blew up a satellite and thought it would fall back to earth but it just broke up and stayed in space in some thousands of pieces. There are also many spent rocket parts floating around. The Air Force can have some of the satellites move to avoid being hit. They move the Space Station several times a week.

That is the good part of their job; the bad part is they need to close down any radio stations in the 440 frequencies for about 150 miles of the base to quiet the noise so they can do their job. This means that we can kiss 440 goodbye in the Bay Area. We do not know for sure if our repeater will be affected when it is back up. We will just have to wait and see if we get a letter.

If you are thinking about a new radio you might think about a 220 radio. We have a good repeater on that band and it needs some use. You can start by checking in on the Tuesday net at 7:30 P.M.


