# WORKSHOPS

## CALLIGRAPHY / Painting with Letters

This workshop will explore the elegance of hand crafted letters using a pointed brush. Key concepts will be explained for laying down elegant strokes. We will work with tools familiar to painters – a round brush, watercolor palette and paper. Time will be spent learning basic strokes and letterforms. Students will examine how they might incorporate words into their art projects. Instructor will demonstrate both the brush and pens which can be used with calligraphy.

Students need to bring with them: basic watercolors (single or double primary colors), round brushes (#4, #6 and/or #8), water container, palette for mixing on, paper (hot press watercolor pad OR Bristol OR mixed media paper 9” x 12” and a willingness to explore. Bring something for lunch or plan to grab a quick lunch locally.

Teacher will provide: practice paper, brush markers for initial exercises, variety of calligraphy inks to test and a love of calligraphy to share.
