FOLLOW SIGNS TO RENDEZVOUS ONCE IN ENCAMPMENT

Dear Bill,
Here is a little history about the Sierra Madre Muzzle Loader Club in Saratoga. Les Daniels wrote this up and narrated it during our break for lunch at The Marion Baker Invitational shoot this past June $3{ }^{\text {rd }}$.

Marion Baker
In the late 70 s, early 80 s Marion Baker was the proprietor of The Brass Rail Saloon north of Saratoga. Her club was a private club open to members only which she called the Sierra Madre Muzzle Loading Rifle Club. Between Marion and George Pearson they built a small 50 yard shooting range just outside the bar. The shoots that she held were for the lucky ones that owned and shot smoke poles The shoots consisted of mostly targets and were supervised by Marion or George. Some shooters even partook in a cold one every now and then.

Marion contacted A.J. White which was at that time NMLRA State Representive for the state of Wyoming and asked him if he would come to Saratoga and educate us all on the Muzzleloading Sport. And of course he said he would. When A. J. arrived from Riverton he was welcomed to her club and immediately began his talk about the muzzle loading family in Wyoming. We were in awe at the possibilities of this way of life. He brought a Mountain Man with him called "Skunk" and he was adorned in his buckskin Regalia and was immediatlely welcomed. Then A.J. brought out the tomahawks and gave us a quick demonstration on the art of throwing Hawk. A.J. and Skunk let us throw their hawks and luckily brought many handles with them. I talked to A.J. a week later and he told me he sold 121 tomahawks that day. He loves Saratoga. Time went by and Marion was planning a large get together at the club only to find out her Liquor License had been shanghaied by the powers that be at the pubs in Saratoga. Nothing could ever be proven but everyone knew what had happened. So the Brass rail was no more and Marion wanted to have her rendezvous. At the time Gary Millhouse and I held offices in the Saratoga Gun Club and we offered the area for the Rendezvous, she was elated, and so in 1983 was the first Rendezvous at the Gun Club. People came from Riverton, Rawlins Dubois, Casper, Glenrock, and Hanna to enjoy this rendezvous. The next rendezvous were held in the mountains west of Saratoga and so it began with the guidance and love of Marion Baker to this day we still persevere, as Marion would say, "Waugh!! Shoot Center!!

## Hole in the Wall, Hole in the Ground Trout

For those of you who like to do a little fishing in the mountains... .this was the best fish I have ever tasted.

I was doing a little paleontology work on the Red Fork of the Powder and took a few hours off to do a little fishing and fix a nice supper. We caught two beautiful brown trout on garden hackle in no time. Since we didn't have all the cooking gear for camping, we had to improvise. This is what we did;

First we dug a 18 " deep pit big enough for both fish. We burned a nice campfire in the pit and made a good coal bed. We then buried the coals with dirt, (just enough to cover all the coals). Then we lined the pit with green grass. We took the cleaned trout and stuffed them with a few wild onions and a small sprig of wild mint. We then wrapped them in the outer layers of corn husks from two ears of corn. We put the corn and the fish in the pit, covered them with grass and then again with dirt. We built another fire on top and let it cook for about an hour; letting the fire and coals burn out Then we dug up the fish and corn and chowed down. The fish was firm and moist. All it needed was a little salt.

This is how I plan to cook trout from now in when camping in the mountains. Hope you find this fun, Melissa
