





The "GREEN" Phase directives do not differ greatly from the Yellow Phase. Therefore we will continue to abide by the following guidelines.

Please see GUIDELINES below!

- The Vigil Mass. 5:00pm & the Sunday 11:00am Masses will take place in the parish social hall. The Sunday 8:00am Mass will be outside in front of the church. Please bring a chair if attending the 8:00am Mass.
 - (No access to the church proper at this time.)
- The social hall door will be unlocked 30 minutes before Mass.
 - (The social hall door will be the only point of entry for Mass.)
- Readings & Mass parts will be on the big screen.
 - (No hymnals, bulletins, booklets or any such items will be distributed)
- Please bring your facemask.
- Windows will be open for ventilation.
- Social distancing-- 6 feet apart. Limited seating will be available.
 - (Chairs are set up accordingly.)
- There will be no offertory procession.
 - (The priest alone will handle the vessels for Mass.)
- There will be no sacristans, altar servers or Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion.
- As you enter the social hall, there is a box for you to insert your offertory contributions.
- Reception of Communion will be done after Mass.
- The worship space will be sanitized after each Mass.
