


## HAT LOOM INSTRUCTIONS

### **WRONG:**

- (A) Loops on inside
- (B) Too many loops/wrapped around tack

### **ROLLED BRIM**




### **THREADING THE RING:**

**\*\*\*Wrap loosely\*\*\***

**Use two yarns together as though they were one.**

1. Attach the yarns to a Velcro dot rather than using the tack on the loom.
2. Wrap yarns between the first two pegs to the inside.
3. Wrapping clockwise around the ring, wrap counter-clockwise around each peg.
4. Continue around ring clockwise until you have two rows (4 yarns) on each peg.

5. Attach the loose ends to the Velcro to keep loops from coming off.



### **WORKING THE RING:**

1. Using the pick, pull up the bottom two yarns and pull them over the top two yarns on each peg.
2. Continue around the ring until you have gone all the way around.



3. Remove the top yarn from the Velcro.
4. Start wrapping the ring again so there is one more row on the pegs.
5. Place working yarn on the Velcro.
6. Continue making rows until you have about 8" (large size) 7" (medium) 6" (small size).
7. Once you have pulled the last row of loops over the pegs you are ready to remove the hat from the loom.

### **REMOVING HAT:**

1. Wrap the working yarns once around the loom and cut.
2. Fold the tips of the yarns over a large-eyed, blunt needle and pinch tightly. Thread the fold through the eye of the needle.
3. Starting at the first peg, put needle down through the first yarn loops on peg 1 and remove from the peg. Slide the loops down the needle and onto the yarn. Continue around until all loops are removed.



4. Draw up the yarn pulling tightly..



5. Turn hat wrong side out. Using the needle, weave the yarn in and out several times until the top is secure and loose ends are hidden.
6. Cut yarn.

### **FINISHING UP:**

1. Take the beginning yarns, thread them through the needle and weave the yarns in and out of several stitches.
2. Cut loose yarns.



### **FOLDED BRIM:**



1. Knit enough rows to equal twice the width you want the brim to be.
2. Fold the knitted part up through the middle attaching the loops on the edge over the pegs.



3. Using the pick, pull the bottom loops over the loops you just put on the pegs.
4. Continue around the loom the same way as you did for the rolled brim, finishing the hat the same way.
