SWINE ARE THE ONLY ANIMALS THAT WILL BE STAYING OVERNIGHT
(Weights must be turned in no later than 8pm Tuesday)

- Masks will be worn in any of the barns at all times.
- Exhibitors will wear masks in the show ring.
- Displays are not allowed.
- No Parking areas will be roped off and enforced.
- Shavings will <u>NOT</u> be supplied.
- No gate charge
- Social distancing will be required on the grounds and in the arena bleachers.
- All entries (including Showmanship) will be made on-line. <u>THERE WILL BE NO ENTRIES DAY OF SHOW.</u>

RULE 1. ELIGIBILITY: Participation in the Swine Division is limited to members in good standing with their 4-H Club or FFA Chapter. Exhibitors must be enrolled in and attending, public or private elementary or secondary school or living in the Southwest Fair District area. Exhibitors may be ages 9-19 and may be in their first semester of college.

RULE 2. ENTRY DEADLINE: Entries will close at midnight September 15, 2020. Please bring your ShoWorks receipt with you. In all cases, the management reserves the right to accept or reject an application for entry.

RULE 3. Arrival and Registration will be Tuesday the 29th from 6pm-8pm. Weights MUST be turned in by 8pm.

Show Order Starting at 9am Wednesday:

Market Hogs	\$20 Entry Fee
Showmanship	\$5 Entry Fee (Paid On-site)
Breeding Swine	\$15 Entry Fee

- **RULE 4**. RELEASE: You may leave as soon as you are done showing, premium checks will be mailed at a later date. Be sure to clean up after yourself and your animals. Failure to do so can cause your premium check to be held. NO SMOKING IN BARNS.
- **RULE 6**. Exhibitor must be able to have full control of animal or risk disqualification.
- **RULE 7**. Southwest Arkansas District Fair and officials shall not be held responsible for any loss or damage to property or the owners thereof.
- **RULE 9**. Only animals that are credible from the standpoint of type, quality and finish shall be eligible for judging. The judge may, at his/her discretion, award placing according to the animal's quality; therefore, a single entry is not automatically awarded first place.
- **RULE 11**. Any violation of these rules will cost a forfeiture of all premiums earned by the exhibitor. In the interest of improving the Junior Show, the Southwest District Fair requests that the County Agents, and Ag. teachers certify as to the eligibility of both the exhibitor and the animal.
- RULE 12. ALL PROTESTS SHALL BE MADE TO THE LIVESTOCK CHAIRMAN IN WRITING IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE CONCLUSION OF JUDGING. SUCH PROTESTS MUST STATE PLAINLY THE CAUSE OF COMPLAINT AND BE ACCOMPANIED BY \$100 DEPOSIT. JUDGING PROCEDURES WILL NOT BE INTERRUPTED FOR PROTEST INVESTIGATION. DECISIONS OF THE LIVESTOCK SHOW CHAIRMAN ARE FINAL, PENDING A COMPLETE INVESTIGATION.
- **RULE 13**. SHOWMANSHIP: Showmanship classes will be judged immediately after market hog show but before breeding swine. Classes: Ages 9-12, Ages 13-15, Ages 16-19. Exhibitors use their actual date of birth to determine which class to enter. **THIS YEAR YOU MUST REGISTER ONLINE FOR SHOWMANSHIP.** A \$5 entry fee must be paid upon entering ring the day of show. Money will be placed in jackpot; winner take all. Each exhibitor entering Showmanship must show his/her own animal.

MARKET HOGS

- 1. There will be no official weigh-in. Each exhibitor must weigh their own entries and submit the weight on weight card. Card must be turned in to Fair Office or Livestock Superintendent by Tuesday, September 29th by 8pm.
- 2. Health papers are required and will be checked.

- 3. Each exhibitor is limited to three entries.
- 4. Weight Minimum 200lbs. Maximum 280lbs.
- 5. Classes and divisions will be determined by weight by show Chairmen.
- 6. Immediately after class judging, the top three animals in each class will be weighed by the Market Hog Superintendent on scales provided by Southwest Arkansas District Fair. Any animals over or under a ten-pound variation from the weight submitted on weight card will be disqualified. *IF YOU ARE NOT READY WHEN YOUR CLASS IS CALLED YOU WILL BE SCRATCHED!*
- 7. Market hogs must be entered by ear tag number or ear notch and have ear tag in one ear prior to entering the fairgrounds
- 8. Purebred gilts are allowed to show in market hog classes, but additional entry online and additional entry fee applies.
- 9. \$5.00 of each entry will be placed in Jackpot and will be paid as follows:

60% Grand Champion 40% Reserve Champion

REGISTERED SWINE

- 1. There will be a limit of two entries per exhibitor, per class.
- 2. Pigs farrowed after May cannot compete.
- 3. Registration papers are to be shown at check-in. No exceptions will be made.
- 4. Breeding Swine will be shown alphabetically.
