
Sew It! Grow It! Show It! The 2017 Verde Valley Fair May 2 – 6, 2018

#### Field Trips

<u>Free:</u> Field trips are open to all Verde Valley Schools\* on Thursday May 4<sup>th</sup>. Groups should plan to arrive between 10:00 and 11:00 am and may stay as long as they like. Students will be able to visit livestock and other exhibits. The carnival will open at 1:00pm and several food vendors will offer a special \$5 lunch to students and their chaperones. Students are welcome to enjoy the rides; ride tickets are available on the grounds.

<u>Field Trips must pre-register</u> and present their confirmations at the gate. Registrations must indicate if students will be riding the rides. Students must be supervised by an adequate number of adults.

### **Special Needs Day**

Students with special needs and challenges are invited to enjoy the fair on Thursday, May 4. Gates open at 10:00 am and the carnival opens at 1:00pm. This program includes free admission and tickets for 6 rides (rides are pre-selected by Brown's Amusements). Several food vendors will be offering a special \$5 lunch deal to students and their chaperones.

Attendees must be pre-registered and provide their confirmation at the gate. Groups should plan to arrive between 11:00am and 12:00noon.
