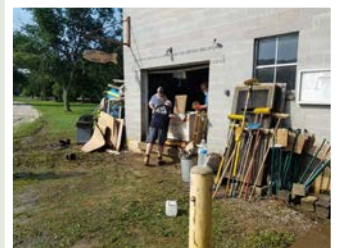
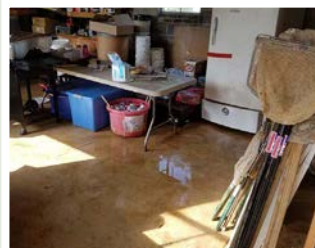
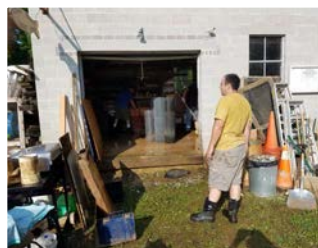

Egg Shoot

In August we'll be hosting a 22lr Egg Shoot on Saturday, August 4th

22LR PRS Match- We will be having a 22lr PRS match on Saturday, August 18th. It will mimic it's big brother long range center fire PRS but scaled down to suit the 22lr cartridge. Multiple positions/presentations will be encountered to get your hits on steel targets. Distances will be from 10yds to 200 yards. Magazine fed rifle mandatory, semi or bolt action is fine. A scope that is capable of dialing elevation or holdover reticle is highly recommended. Registration will be on practiscore, and an account will have to be set up. <https://practiscore.com/york-precision-rimfire-match-august-2018/register>

2018 Falling Steel Championship September 29th and 30th 2018

- The match will consist of 6 stages, 25-35 targets per stage. 150-170 total.
- All knockdown steel will be used.
- Squads will be limited to 12 shooters per squad (72 shooters per time slot). If the time slot you requested is filled, you will be notified and given the option to select another one, if available.
- Shooters may shoot in three divisions; however, you must shoot in three different time slots.
- You may shoot as "Single" meaning you shoot by yourself, or as "Team" meaning you and another shooter will be shooting each stage simultaneously. In theory each teammate only has half the targets, and each team only pays one entry fee. \$30 per time slot.
- You may only enter once per time slot (either as a single or partner).

Other News

Orientations - Orientations, where we tour the grounds and discuss rules and features of the club are mandatory for prospective members, and interesting for existing members. The next three for 2018 will be: Sunday, August 5th at 1:00 pm, Saturday, September 1st at 1:00 pm, and Saturday, October 6th also at 1:00 pm. Everyone is welcome to attend. We meet in the upper floor of the clubhouse. Prospective new members should be reminded that our dues are by the calendar year now. If you join later in the year they are still \$110 per year and only through the end of 2018.

Club Championship - The Club Championship has been postponed until later in the fall. Think Youth Field Day shooting events for adults. We will shoot 4 events that day: One 25 bird round of trap, 25 clay birds at 20 yards with an iron sighted revolver or semi-auto pistol, 25 clay birds at 50 yards offhand with an iron sighted or scoped rifle, and 25 clay birds at 30 yard with a hunting class long, recurve or compound bow. No crossbows, magnification, or electronics on bows please.

You use your own firearms, ammo, bow and arrows. The Club Champion will be the person with the highest cumulative score. You may shoot less than the four events. The fee is \$20. To pre-register send a check for \$20 made to "York Izaak Walton" to Howard C. Thompson 53 N Main St. Stewartstown PA 17363 or bring cash or check to any meeting and give it to Howard or Gary. 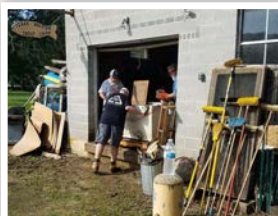


Top Row, Left to right: Don Robertson, John Detisch, Tracey Longenecker, Bill Stone.
