GOLF CART OR ELECTRIC VEHICLE RULES AND REGULATIONS

In an effort to allow the use of golf carts within The Waters, while attempting to promote safety within the community, the following rules have been established for all Members who operate golf carts within The Waters. The Waters Assembly will permit the use of golf carts on the private streets owned by The Waters in accordance with these rules and regulations. Compliance with these rules does not guarantee compliance with local, state or federal law and owners are advised to investigate all other applicable laws or regulations.

In order to assist in providing safety for everyone in the neighborhood the following registration requirements and rules have been established. Anyone operating a golf cart must be observant of, and attentive to, the safety of themselves and others including their passengers, other motorists, bicyclists, and pedestrians. Everyone who operates or rides in golf carts on the streets within The Waters does so at their OWN RISK. The Assembly assumes no liability by permitting golf carts to be operated on The Waters streets.

Registration:

Assembly Members are allowed to use privately owned golf carts on The Waters streets so long as the following guidelines are met:

1. A Registration Form and a release of liability and indemnification agreement (the "Registration Form") must be completed by each golf cart owner who intends to use a golf cart on the private streets within The Waters. Only Assembly Members shall be entitled to register a golf cart in accordance with the rules.
2. All owners of golf carts being used on The Waters property must obtain golf cart general liability insurance and provide evidence of such insurance to The Waters Assembly, **prior to use** on The Waters property. Once the Registration Form and proof of insurance is provided and accepted by The Assembly, the Member will receive a Waters Golf Cart Permit evidencing proof of insurance and approval to operate the Member's golf cart on The Waters private streets and green space. (Members should review their individual insurance policy with the carriers to ensure that **liability coverage** is in place; not just asset replacement.) The Waters streets are privately owned and any golf cart without a valid permit sticker will not be allowed on the streets. Non-permitted golf carts can be towed without notice at the owners expense.
3. At the time of registration, the Member must provide a certificate of insurance establishing that the operation of the golf cart is covered by a liability insurance policy with a combined single limit of at least \$100,000 per occurrence for bodily injury and property damage coverage. **The Waters Assembly, Inc., New Waters, LLC, and New Waters Realty Company, LLC, shall be named as a certificate holder** on any policy. The policy shall state that all certificate holders shall be given at least ten (10) days prior written notice to the non-renewal, lapse, cancellation, or termination of the policy. Additionally, by completing the Registration Form, the Member covenants and agrees to maintain this coverage as long as the golf cart is operated on The Waters property.

4. The registered Member shall be responsible for all loss, damage, injury, claims or other liability resulting from the use of the golf cart within The Waters community, regardless of who may be operating the golf cart at the time the damage, loss or injury occurs.

Rules:

1. All carts must be registered prior to operation within The Waters community.
2. Only golf carts with valid permits shall be allowed to operate within The Waters Community.
3. Golf carts may only be driven between dawn and dusk unless equipped with headlights, tail lights, and brake lights in operating condition.
4. Only electric golf carts are allowed. **Gas operated carts are not allowed.**
5. Four wheelers and other such ATVs are not allowed on The Waters streets or green space.
6. Golf carts should be maintained in a presentable and first-class manner.
7. Golf carts shall be operated with the same caution as exercised in operating a car, and must abide by all traffic regulations applicable to vehicular traffic.
8. Golf carts must yield to on-coming vehicular traffic and pedestrians.
9. Pedestrians shall always be given the right-of-way at intersections and crossings.
10. Golf cart racing, of any form, is NOT allowed within The Waters Community.
11. Golf carts are not allowed on sidewalks or pedestrian designated pathways; unless otherwise authorized by The Assembly Management.
12. Golf carts are to be parked in areas designated for vehicular or golf cart parking except for those areas on private property that are approved as designated golf-cart parking by The Assembly Management.
13. All designated golf cart parking must be located in a screened location behind homes, unless otherwise approved by The Waters ARB.
14. Golf carts can be used for bank fishing so long as use does not damage The Waters property.
15. All passengers must be properly seated while cart is in motion and may not be transported in a negligent manner or in a manner inconsistent with the cart manufacturer's recommendations. The number of passengers shall not exceed the seating capacity of the cart, including the driver.
16. Golf carts may only be driven by persons age 14 or older.
17. Persons driving the golf cart are prohibited from use of electronic devices while cart is in operation.

The Waters Management has the right to prohibit any party from using The Waters streets for golf carts or electric vehicles for non-compliance with the above rules and regulations.
