Do you believe everything you read in the newspapers? What about the information given on TV news or radio talk shows? A Roper survey showed that even though Americans overwhelmingly (80 percent) believe that the press is essential to a free society, only 2 percent believe everything a newspaper reporter tells them. For TV news anchors, the trust level is only at 5 percent. And for radio talk-show hosts, that figure drops to 1 percent. Justified or not, it seems that we don't trust our news sources.

A Reliable News Source

There is one news source, however, that will pass the test of 100-percent reliability. It's the biblical record of the "good news" of Jesus Christ. Delivered by men whose words were inspired by the Holy Spirit, the Bible has been safeguarded from error. It is the absolute truth about man, God, sin, and salvation.

King David wrote about the reliability of God's Word. In Psalm 19, he called God's law perfect, His testimony sure, and His judgments "true and righteous altogether" (Psalm 19:7,9).

But even more important than revering God's Word, we must learn it and live it! Read the Gospels, pore over the Epistles, ponder the Psalms and the Prophets. The Bible has news you can trust and news you can use!

Why We Observe The Lord's Supper Every Sunday!

We in the churches of Christ observe the Lord's Supper on Sunday for that is the "example" given us by the early church under the direction of inspired men. "And upon the first day of the week, when we were gathered together to break bread, Paul discoursed with them ..." (Acts 20:7). This is indeed a fitting day to remember the Lord for it is the day on which He arose from the dead (Mark 16:9) and was declared to be the Son of God with power (Romans 1:4).

We observe the Lord's Supper on every Sunday for the same reason we observe it on Sunday in the first place, we have an approved apostolic example. "Which week?" one might ask. The week which has a "first day" is our reply. The Jews kept the Sabbath. How often did they keep it? Every week that had a Sabbath, which of course, was every week. The early church was also to give on the first day of the week (1 Corinthians 16:2). The Greek in this verse literally means "on the first day of every week" and is so rendered by the New American Standard Version. So, on the first day of every week, they communed and gave.

We take the Lord's Supper only on the first day of the week because that is the only day we have authority from the Scriptures to take it. "And whatsoever ye do, in word or in deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him" (Colossians 3:17). The consequence of adding to what the Lord has approved is set forth in the following verse: "Whosoever goeth onward and abideth not in the teaching of Christ, hath not God: he that abideth in the teaching, the same hath both the Father and the Son" (2 John 1:9).
