2022 Scholarship Summary


- 176 Applications were received.

- 126 were preliminarily approved.
 - o Of those, 12 did not submit confirmation of full-time enrollment.
 - 114 checks issues @ \$900 each Total \$102,600.

2022 Observations and Suggestion

- Total applications received in 2022 vs. 2021 were down by 38 or 17.76 %
- Total applications approved in 2022 vs 2021 were down by 37 or 22.70%
- Total checks issued in 2022 vs 2021 were down by 25 or 17.98%
- Total award in 2022 vs 2021 increased to \$102,600 or 5.44%



- We need to spread the word to the various detachments nationwide. As can be seen by the applications received, the majority of applications are coming from NJ and PA, with very few from other states.
- Detachment members must be better informed of the scholarship requirements, as we received a number of applications that were incomplete, due to sponsor error.
- Better communication is needed with individual applicants. Numerous calls from parents and applicants asking when various lists would be available, when checks would be issued and when the coming year application would be published.
- Checks need to be issued in a timelier manner. We received quite a number of calls asking when checks would be issued as tuition payments were coming due.

As a closing note, I believe I can speak for all the members of the committee in saying what a pleasure it was working both with each other, but also working with the various detachment members and sponsors, MCL National and The MCL foundation representatives.
