

Raider Xtreme Families,

We are so excited to be back in the gym. Our first week went very well with our new procedures. Beginning June 1st, these will be the new drop off and pick up procedures. We appreciate your cooperation to help make this process seamless. We want to ensure your child and our staff are in the safest atmosphere possible.

ENROLLMENT

All developmental classes resumed Monday, May 18th. If your child did not attend the first week, we have dropped them in order to avoid unwanted charges to your account. If you would like to continue, please give our office a call at (806) 795-2222 and we can easily reinstate your enrollment. If you are not planning to continue with classes through the summer, please contact our office so that your account is not charged, and your child's enrollment can be dropped.

CAPACITY

Per the Governors' announcement, we will continue at a 25% capacity limit in the initial phases. Due to this, all classes will be TEMPORARILY CLOSED to parent viewing. Please feel free to stay in your vehicle in the parking lot during your child's class. We are working with a software program to incorporate a live stream service for all parents. More information to follow.

NEW CHECK IN POLICY EFFECTIVE 5.25.20

Every child will enter through our main entrance to be checked in and escorted by an instructor to their class area. Upon class completion, children will exit through our east side door located under the big Raider X logo on the side of the building. Please be prompt in picking up your children as we will be staying within our 25% capacity rate during drop off and pick-up.

All children must be checked in with a Raider Xtreme staff member before entering the building for class. Parents, legal guardians, grandparents, babysitters, etc. will NOT be allowed to enter the facility during this phase of opening. All drop off and pick-up protocol will happen outside, in front of our assigned entrance and exit doors.

WHAT TO BRING

Please have your child bring a water bottle. We are not allowed to use a public water source at this time and will not be able to sell concessions during our initial phase of re-opening.

RULES & POLICIES

Our rules and policies have been updated as of May 12th, 2020. You will need to log on to your customer portal account and accept the new rules and policies in order for your child to remain enrolled in Raider Xtreme classes. If the rules and policies are not accepted, your child will not be able to participate in classes at Ready Set Go. We have heightened our cleaning process and have been working diligently in the gym to keep our facility as safe and clean as possible.

PAYMENT

Regular monthly billing will resume Monday, June 1st, and all accounts will be drafted the first business day of the month.

CLASS MODIFICATIONS

In our efforts to maintain social distancing, we will not plan on activities that require spotting and/or hands on. This includes spotting on all events and rotations. We are aware that spotting is an essential part of training gymnastics to prevent injury and will be done when absolutely necessary. We will be organizing classes and lesson plans to encourage 6' of physical separation. Children will maintain their own training spaces without waiting in lines. Markers may be used to maintain distancing requirements. All 55 minute classes will be 45 minutes and 90 minute classes will be 75 minutes in order to allow adequate cleaning time.

PPE

Masks are not mandatory to wear during class periods, but we do ask that all participants wear a mask upon entering and exiting the facility. Please feel free to have your child wear a mask of their choice. We will have masks on site to supply to the children if they are in need of one. Our staff will be wearing masks when they are in close proximity to your child, during class initiation, and when students are escorted to their parents at the completion of class. We are performing wellness screenings on all of our employees upon arriving for their shift and also for all children enrolled in classes.

CONCESSION SALES

Please be aware that during this phase, all sales of concession items are not allowed. This includes drinks, snacks, and cups of water. Each child will be responsible to bring their own personally labeled water bottle to their class time. Students will be assigned a location to store their bottle during their class period.
