President's Message

After 40 years of existence, there are obviously some noteworthy occurrences for our men's club. Here are a few that you may recall.

Popular member Tom Nicolai, who will be departing for St. George, Utah shortly, pulled off the rarest of golf shots on January 14, 2004. Tom hit his drive on the par 5 third hole on Butterfield Stage some 330 yards down the fairway. A perfect 5 iron that found the bottom of the cup resulted in the extraordinary double eagle that most of us can only read about.



Around 1990 the upper tee was built on the par 3 seventh hole of Chino Creek. Shortly after its construction, former member Paul Dayton, in a Saturday Skins Game, knocked it in the cup with a perfect 3 iron. It was Paul's second hole in one. This feat is not likely to be duplicated by a member as this tee is rarely used in men's club events. Paul was never a long hitter and ultimately never carried a wood in his bag, satisfied to tee off with an iron on every hole. In later years when play from this tee, Paul would lay up with a wedge to the ladies tees to help insure he could carry the pond.

Tom Clark is still listed in the SCGA's "Directory of Golf" as the owner of the course record on Butterfield Stage with a sizzling 62. The directory doesn't identify a course record on Chino Creek but a couple of El Prado members may also lay claim to that accomplishment. Former member Billy Mouw was the first to shoot a 63 in the early 2000's and that score was later tied on February 7, 2004 by Rick Kerian.

Come join us in our Tuesday and Saturday skins games or our monthly tournaments and perhaps the game may reward you with a memorable moment.

We had a total of 90 players tee it up in two man teams better ball. It was gratifying to get such a nice turn out.

However, I did get several **late** sign ups which causes quite a bit of problems setting up the tournament. **Please sign up on time**. Please be aware that there are only two options with late sign ups: 1) I can just add the players into the flight which is limited to just one or two. 2) if there are too many player additions, the entire field is skewed, and then I have to reset the entire field. This can create a quite lot of work on everyone; changes in the course reservations, resetting people to new flights, resetting new tee times, redoing labels, redoing the scoreboard, redoing the sign in sheets, re-posting and notifying everyone of all the changes, and then we have to hope that everything works out and errors do not occur.

We have to improve in two areas:

- 1. Get your entries in on time. The Saturday one week before the tournament.
- No matter what your tee time is, check in at the tournament table no later than one hour before the last tee time. People who continue to violate this policy will not be given late tee times.

Winners were Mike Cole/Brian King 57 to take the top spot on A flight, Ron Bowles/Jim Moir B flight with 63, Bob Johns/ Tom Canfield with 58 C flight, and Steve Pope/Jim Brown 58 D flight. Thanks to Kevin and Greg for their continued support with our tournaments and Kevin for manning the scoreboard and help with the results. When you see them please let them know how much we appreciate the help and support they give to the club.

Remember, we are the members of El Prado Mens Club and this is our home course. Take care of your divots, repair ball marks, fix pitch marks, drive your carts through the rough instead of the fairways. Play quickly and keep up with the group in front of you.

On August 13th, our next tournament will be the ever popular 2 Man 4 Club Red Tees Better Ball Tournament. We usually get a large field for this event so make sure you find your partner and get your entry in early. Entries are due by August 6th. This is a one course tournament which will be held on Chino Creek due to the course punching and aerification on the Butterfield side. This mean there will be more late times than usual.
