

# Preschool Summer Programs at Monroe Montessori School

Summer Camp offers opportunities for children ages 3 through 6 to work in a Montessori classroom emphasizing self-directed development, refinement and progress. This program runs from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. and offers indoor and outdoor activities. Half day classes from 8:30-11:30 are also available.

Summer Camp is focused on learning through discovery. Taught by experienced Montessori teachers, the summer program encourages choices of curriculum that include Practical Life, Sensorial, Mathematics, Language Arts, Science and Cultural Studies as well as the theme of the session.

While each morning students work on classroom activities, afternoons are a time when the teacher reads stories to the children, organizes group games and group interactions, as well as following up morning lessons with activities that reinforce the discovery of new ideas. There is also time set aside to enjoy summer, interact with friends, run through the sprinkler on special days and discover the great outdoors. The teachers have many local outings planned that will keep each day inter-

esting, enjoyable, restful in the afternoon and just the right pace.

The before and after school program provides your child a warm, friendly environment consistent with the Montessori philosophy of respect, consistency and stability. Extended Day is available from 7:00—8:30 am and from 3:30—6:00 pm.

Please note: On warm, sunny days children may participate in outdoor water play. It works best if children bring their swimsuits to school each day. You will also need to pack a towel and a change of clothes along with a bag for the wet clothes. Also, please be sure to put sunblock on your children prior to arrival time. Sun hats and sun shirts are encouraged.

1 June 24 - June 28	<b>Gardening (Part 1):</b> Come have fun in the Garden! This week we will be learning all about seeds and planting a vegetable garden. Children will be learning to dissect seeds and lima beans to find the root and shoot growing inside. We will learn about seed identification and pollination. The children will plant healthy growing snacks (sugar snap peas, carrots and tomatoes) that they can tend to throughout the summer. 2 July 8 - July 12	<b>Gardening (Part 2):</b> We continue our study of gardening with flower identification, parts of the flower and pollination. We will also plant sunflowers to bring home as well as do science experiments with carnation flowers and introduce flower farming. 3 July 15 - July 19	<b>Farm (Part 1):</b> This week is all about life on the farm. We will learn about tractors, hay and the larger animals found on a farm including cows, pigs, horses, llamas, sheep and goats. 4 July 22 - July 26	<b>Farm (Part 2):</b> Participants will learn about some smaller farm friends such as hens and roosters. We will dissect chicken eggs to better explore the parts of the egg.
