Lake Shadows Civic League Members:

We, the Lake Shadows Civic League Board, would like to ask for your help to move forward with the improvements of our community amenities. We need feedback from you. We need to know what amenity improvements you most value. Remember we have very limited funds for our budget every year. The community pool has, historically, taken a very large chunk of these funds. That doesn't mean we cannot continue to make some improvements each year even if they are small.

This is a list of some things we have discussed this year. Please, circle/underline or indicate in any way those items you value most. Read through them and note the differences.

AMENITY IMPROVEMENTS:

- 1. Playground surfacing (sand) and bordering (Park only)
- Playground surfacing (sand) and bordering (boat ramp area only)
- 3. Playground surfacing (sand) and bordering (park and boat ramp)
- 4. New Playground Equipment (park and boat ramp area)
- 5. New Playground Equipment (park only)
- 6. New Playground Equipment (boat ramp only)

A resident with law enforcement has recommended we improve the lighting in our parks to make them safer and deter unwanted activities and vandalism.

- 7. Playground Lighting (boat ramp only) Add 1 light over playground area. Currently the only electrical service to this area is from the WDIC #70. This would be a new installation with pole and meter.
- 8. Playground Lighting (park only) -Add 1 light over playground area
- 9. Playground Lighting (boat ramp and park) —Add 2 lights one in each playground area. Currently the only electrical service to the boat ramp area is from the WDIC #70. This would be a new installation with meter.
- 10. Pool -repair concrete around pool and repair lighting in the pool. The concrete around the pool is unlevel and will become a tripping hazard. The in-pool lighting does not work and has not worked for some time. Because of this we cannot open the pool after dark due to safety reasons. Lighting repair requires that some concrete around the pool to be removed to get to the wiring. This is most efficiently done while the concrete around the pool is being repaired. NOTE: if the concrete around the pool is not repaired, eventually, the pool will be shut down due to safety reasons.

11. Pool – Repair ONLY the concrete around the pool. **NOTE:** This will prevent the pool from being shut down completely due to safety issues. However, it will still not be opened at night due to safety issues (in-pool lights).

HOW WOULD YOU LIKE TO PAY FOR THE IMPROVEMENTS?

- 1. I would be in favor of shutting down the pool for 1 summer season and use the funds usually budgeted for the pool to improve our other amenities.
- 2. I would be in favor of keeping the pool open and making small improvements to the other amenities as the funds are available.
- 3. I would be in favor of shutting down and removing the pool permanently. There would be a large cost to remove the pool. However, it would be a one-time cost and would free up more monies for the remaining amenities every year thereafter.
- 4. I would like to volunteer to help with improvements to our amenities. (This might include, but not limited to, taking purchased materials and assembling equipment and putting it in place in the playgrounds, helping with pool repairs, installing poles for lighting in playground areas, removing and hauling off old equipment, and anything else to benefit Lake Shadows).
