Quarterly Giving Statements

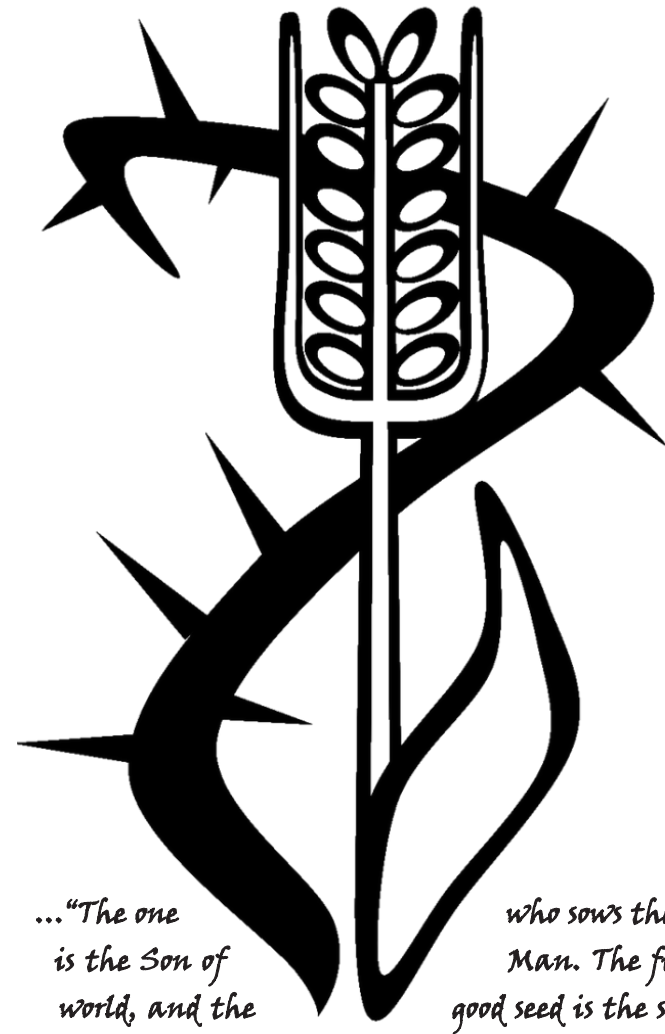
The end of June marked the end of the second quarter of 2020. Giving statements are being prepared and will be placed in your mailbox in the narthex.
