

Rockford Town Council Special Meeting December 8, 2023, 6pm

Ms. Roecks called the special meeting to order at 4:03pm with the Pledge of Allegiance. Ms. Roecks stated that the purpose of the special meeting was to discuss the purchase of a motor for the town's 2008 F350 service truck.

Roll call took place. Those present were Mayor Carrie Roecks and Councilmembers Walt Whitman, Micki Harnois and Clint Stevenson. Councilmembers Walt Whitman and Kevin Willms were not present. Clerk/Treasurer Heidi Johnson, and Public Works' Dave Thompson were also in attendance.

Mr. Stevenson made a motion to approve the agenda. Mr. Whitman seconded the motion. Motion carried.

The council members in attendance discussed the purchase of a new motor for the town's service truck. Mr. Whitman and Mr. Thompson have been working on getting quotes from different entities. Their recommendation is to purchase a motor for S&J Engines out of Spokane, who quoted the best price and already has a 2008 motor in line for assembly.

Mr. Stevenson made a motion to approve the S&J Engines quote for \$6,417.48. Mr. Whitman seconded the motion. There was discussion about who will install the new motor and the cost of labor. Mr. Stevenson suggested servicing the transmission while the old motor was out and before the new one is installed. Motion carried.

Mr. Whitman made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Mr. Stevenson seconded the motion. Motion carried.
