RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT HOUSE BILL 4916

WHEREAS: Michigan State Representatives Glenn, Kelly, Chatfield, Robinson, Lucido, Runestad, Hooker, Barrett, Howrylak, McCready, Dianda, Goike, Sarah Roberts and Garret have introduced House Bill 4916 on September 29, 2015 and was referred to the Committee on Energy Policy, a bill to amend Public Act 3 of 1939 and adding to MCL 460.1 to 460.11 section 10ff.

WHEREAS: Section 10ff states in summary that a customer may choose between the placement of a traditional analog meter or an advanced, digital "smart meter."

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tuscarora Township Board of Trustees supports House Bill 4916 allowing utility customers the option of retaining their analog meters and all language inclusive to the proposed amendment, MCL.10ff.


