

## Dwarf Conifer and Evergreen Favorites

**Abies koreana 'Silberpearle'**: Silver and blue in color, beautiful accent, recurved foliage

**Abies concolor 'Winter Gold'**: Slow growing with light green foliage and yellow new growth in summer, bright yellow in winter

**Buxus 'Green Velvet'**: Slow growing and compact, tiny leaves, emerald green in color

**Chamaecyparis nootkatensis 'Green Arrow'**: Blue/Green in color, very narrow, upright

**Chamaecyparis obtusa 'Butterball'**: Confetti-like splashes of multi-toned yellows highlight small spaces in the landscape

**Chamaecyparis obtusa 'Chirimen'**: Upright, grey/green foliage, delicate in appearance

**Juniperus horizontalis 'Mother Lode'**: Yellow ground cover

**Juniperus scopulorum 'Blue Haven'**: Tall and fairly narrow at 3.5, best blue color, disease and bug resistant

**Pinus aristata 'Blue Heron'**: Blue/green, upright, requires protection from hot sun

**Pinus densiflora 'Umbraculifera'//Tanyosho Pine**: Red bark, open canopy, med needle length

**Pinus parviflora 'Goldilocks'**: Twisted needles, bright gold in color, with hints of blue green

**Pinus parviflora 'Ogon Janome'**: Variegated yellow and green, compact

**Taxus baccata 'Silver Spire'**: Slow growing, prefers some shade and wind break, great for a small space

**Tsuga canadensis 'Horsford Contorted'**: Hint of blue, low growing, great branch structure

**Tsuga canadensis 'Jeddeloh'**: Weeping, can form a ground cover. Also can be trained with a leader, encouraging a strict weeping tree

**Tsuga canadensis 'Abbott's Pygmy'**: Tight foliage, deep green in color and compact

**Azalea 'Silver Sword'**: Variegated white and green, bright pink flowers

**Ginkgo biloba 'Jade Butterflies'**: Very slow growing, round shape

**Ginkgo biloba 'Tubiformis'**: Tube-like leaves, tall and somewhat narrow

**Ginkgo biloba 'Weeping Wonder'**: A true specimen, weeping with unusual leaf structure

**Ilex x meserveae 'Honey Maid'**: Creamy variegation, stunning when berries are present

**Ilex 'Serendipity'**: Dark green, shiny leaves, prolific berries

**Rhododendron 'Mist Maiden'**: By far the most interesting of all Rhodo's, leaves are green on top and velvety tan on bottom, pale pink flowers
